


### SHARED STRUGGLE AND SOLIDARITY STREAM 2021 EVALUATION REPORT

#### **Executive Summary**

The Creation's Shared Struggle and Solidarity Stream 2021 grant funded projects that focused on strengthening solidarity among BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, and People of Color) youth and providing opportunities for relationship-building. With the grant funding, BIPOC youth leaders were able to expand cultural connection programming in their communities, foster solidarity among BIPOC participants, enhance the well-being of youth, and promote leadership and solidarity building. The projects were successful in aiding BIPOC youth in community building, supporting wellness initiatives, sharing cultural knowledge, and empowering the active engagement of BIPOC youth. Despite challenges such as scheduling issues, staff changes, and material delivery, grantees effectively overcame difficulties through their adaptability, flexibility, and problem-solving skills. Youth leaders gained valuable skills in communication, cultural awareness, and relationship building through their projects. The reported outcomes included achieving project goals, such as community building, cultural awareness, the creation of safe and inclusive spaces, and enhanced cross-cultural understanding.



# % STREAM FUNDING AMOUNT BY BUDGET ITEM CATEGORY




